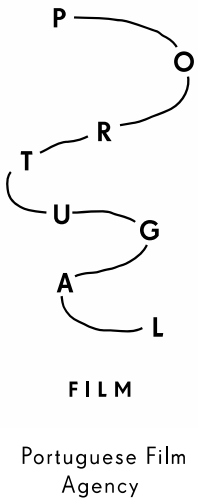

João Miguel Real graduated in Engineering from Faculdade Técnica de Lisboa. Early on, he opted for the Audiovisuals, which always nourished his great passion. During the university period, he graduated in arts, from illustration to animation, in which he became professional. He collaborated in the past with various animation studios and production companies, as 3Dcities, Mylko, Sardinha em Lata,, Bang Bang Animation, Showoff and Take It Easy, which he now takes over as Director, Animation Director and Compositing
